Emmylou Harris & Rodney Crowell/Robert Ellis

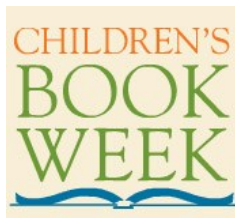
