Tuesday, Oct. 29—Noon-8 p.m.





A referendum to increase funding for the GFJ Memorial Library in Endicott and Your Home Public Library in Johnson City will be placed on the Fall 2019 ballot. This is the first funding increase in 5

years. It will be **Proposition # 1 and located on the back of the ballot**. A typical home (\$75,000) will see an increase of \$4.92 per year.

There will be Information Sessions on Oct. 24 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. in the Scott room of the GFJ Library and on Oct. 17 at 2 p.m. at Your Home Public Library in Johnson City.
