For those doing it curbside, you will need to park in one of the curbside spaces in our back parking lot, call the Children's department to let us know you are there and then a librarian will bring out three books for you to choose between.

ADULT/TEEN PROGRAMS FOR AUGUST

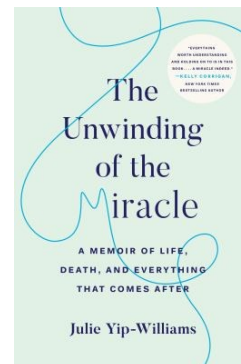
August 14—Drawing for Adult Summer Reading prizes. Please make sure you have dropped off any reading logs, or recorded your information on the Readsquared page:
