The GFJ Book Club will meet via Zoom on January 27 at 1 p.m. to discuss The Dutch House by Anne Patchett.

If you are looking for a book and can't find it at any of the libraries in our system, we have a solution— you can request an out-ofsystem interlibrary loan (ILL).

An out-of-system ILL request is used to borrow books or other materials not available in our Four County Library System and can be requested at the information desk (both children's and adult).

Delivery of ILL items can take from 2-6 weeks depending on the location of the item. If you have a specific deadline, let us know when you place your request. Staff will let you know if we can't get an item. You will be notified when the item is available for pick-up and a fee of \$.25 is due at the time of the check out.

Due dates are determined by the lending library and no renewals are allowed. You may request an item again after 90 days.
