A Romance Reading for the Holidays @ the GFJ Library

Long-time Southern Tier resident and author Louise Donohue (pen name GL Robinson) will read a short story she published last year in a collection titled **The Kissing Ball.**

Louise has published nine historical romances all set in the Regency period in England, (1811-1820). In this Christmas-themed story, a young woman turns up at a St. Nicholas' Party believing herself to be betrothed to the son of the house, an arrangement apparently made years ago between his father and hers, his best friend from their Oxford days. Unfortunately, the son knows nothing about it and is actually in love with someone else. This lighthearted story plays itself out against the background of the London Christmas season, with chestnuts roasting in the streets, the Messiah in the concert halls and Yule logs burning in drawing room fireplaces.

Masks and social distancing are required. There will be time for questions for the author and signed books will be available to purchase.
