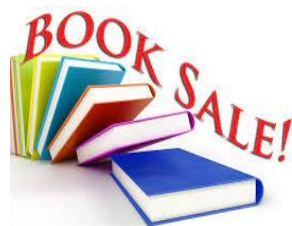

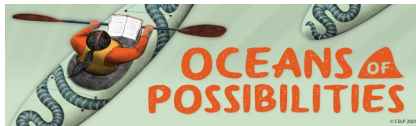
Kids Reading club: Children birth through grade 6 can register in person to receive a paper reading log or participate virtually by going to the READsquared address:

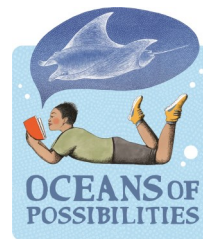
