

# MARCH HIGHLIGHTS


Looking for a place to meet? We're getting ready to debut our newest meeting rooms! The final strategic goal of our <u>2019–2023 strategic</u> <u>plan</u> was to create ample meeting room space in the library. Recently, the Casey Room, located on the library's main floor, has been converted into two meeting rooms. The rooms feature new fire-resistant carpet, doors, drywall, paint, and noise-reducing insulation. They can accommodate groups of up to 10 and 6 people. In addition, an interactive display in the larger





meeting room will allow groups to be productive in reaching their goals, both virtually and in person. Each meeting room has also been equipped with whiteboards for traditional learning and collaboration needs. The rooms will soon be available for patrons to reserve online; there is no charge to use the meeting rooms. The rooms were primarily funded with New York State construction grant funds, which covered 90% of the project's cost. If you're looking for a room for a group of a different size, you can still look into reserving our Scott Room or one of our study rooms.
