2022 marked GFJ's 107th year of service to the Greater Endicott community. We remained dedicated to fulfilling our library's mission. This has included Tech Center classes and individual tech assistance, story times, book clubs for all ages, take & make activities and more. We continue to offer our curbside pickup service. We were again an early polling location in 2022 and were pleased to have many Broome County residents vote at the library. We purchased a C-Pen last year which reads text aloud and can be used at the library to help those with visual and reading difficulties. We began offering Hoopla in 2022 to allow more options for our patrons to download eBooks, audiobooks, music, television shows, and movies.

We enjoyed seeing our patrons at many programs that we hosted in 2022. Last summer and fall we worked with the Village of Endicott to host music concerts on our campus. The Tech Center staff has visited Good Shepherd Village to provide tech assistance to their residents. Teens deciphered clues and solved puzzles at our Mystery Night and Escape Room programs. The Children's Department hosted the therapy dogs and held board game programs for all ages.

We have already completed a capital improvement project this year. Recently, we renovated the Casey Room on the library's main floor, which now encompasses two meeting rooms. The renovation included new fire-resistant carpet, drywall, insulation, paint, doors, baseboards, whiteboards, and an interactive display. This project was made possible due to NYS library construction grant funds. I thank our local legislators, Assemblywoman Donna Lupardo and former Senator Fred Akshar, for working diligently to procure this funding.

Thank you for your continued support of our library and community. Without you, none of this would be possible.
