



Servant and master am I, servant of those dead, master of those living. Through me, spirits immortal speak the message that makes the world weep, and laugh, and wonder, and worship.




In athletics, many juniors sparkled. The football team was captained by a member of this class. Many others contributed to the victories of teams throughout the year.

With all this harmonious practice, the Class of '61 is now ready to carry on the refrain that the senior class has played so well.
















