Mathletes

The NYS Math League Contest is given six times a year at each participating school so all members participate. Our scores are compared to those in a 3 county region. The Broome Co. Mathletes conduct five contests a year at Johnson City High School. Eight schools from our area compete at each meet. A team consists of eight students — U-E fields two teams. 

Co-Operative Office Skills Program



This program has the advantage of coordinating theory and practice for the benefit of the student, school, and employer. It is a plan whereby business students may receive Regents credit for actual work experience in approved jobs that are related to a course in which they are enrolled. Students who maintain satisfactory grades and earn a satisfactory job performance rating by their employer and supervising teacher may receive credit. One-half unit is earned for working each 150 hours up to a maximum of two credits per year for 600 or more hours. The group meets in school periodically with the advisor, Mr. William Dupkanick.

Once, near the beginning of each school year, the co-op and their parents/guardians meet with business teachers and school personnel to have an orientation meeting. 
Lady Tigers


Much of the success of the U-E baseball program is due to excellent coaching, Pete Sylvester, and JV coach Ed Folli.




The team loses only five players through graduation but two are the goalies where replacement will have to be found. Other than that position, the teams returning should be very competitive again.


This has been another good season for the JV wrestling team. Despite having to give up two forfeits in our upper weights every match, we finished the season with a 12-3 record.

On Thursday, January 4th, a man named Duncan Inches gave a lecture which he entitled," A Little Touch Of Will." His approach to William Shakespeare was quite unique. 

Voyager capped its historic 4.43-billion-mile, 12-year tour of four planets when it skimmed 3,048 miles over Neptune's north pole in August, then dove past Triton, the planet's largest moon. It made its closest approach about 23,900 miles above the moon's surface at 2:10 a.m. on 8/25/90. Voyager was nearly 4.5 billion miles along a curving path that took it from Earth in 1977, past Jupiter in 1979, Saturn in 1981 and Uranus in 1986, and now past Neptune in search of the edge of the solar system. Voyager 1 explored Jupiter in 1979 and Saturn in 1980.



SAN FRANCISCO EARTHQUAKE

A catastrophic earthquake rocked Northern California on October 17, killing at least 62 people and injuring hundreds, caving in bridges and freeways, igniting fires and causing widespread damage to buildings.

The quake which struck during the evening rush hour, just as Game 3 of the World Series was about to begin, registered 6.9 on the Richter scale and was on the notorious San Andreas Fault. It was the second deadliest in the nation's history, exceeded only by the 1906 San Francisco earthquake that destroyed much of the city and killed more than 700 people.
