# SR. OFFICERS

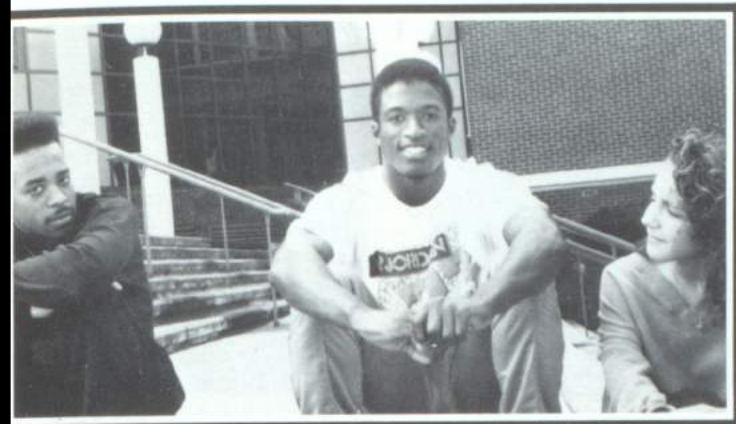

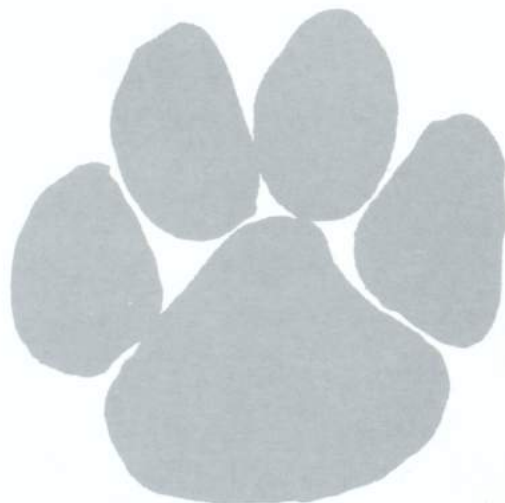
# **JUNIOR CLASS OFFICERS**

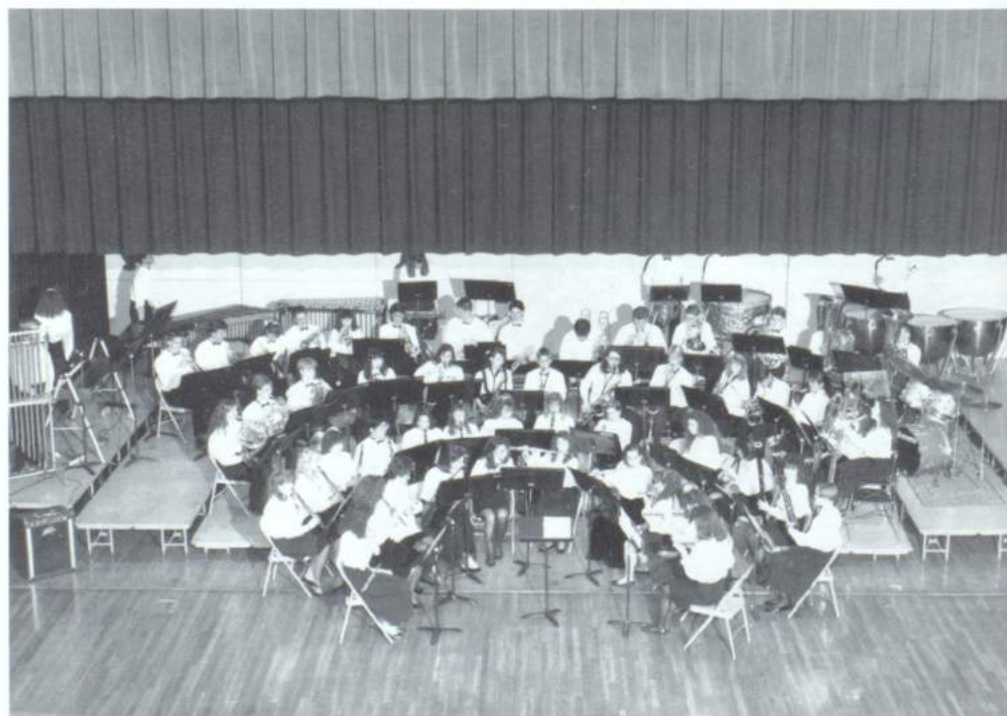
## Concert Band

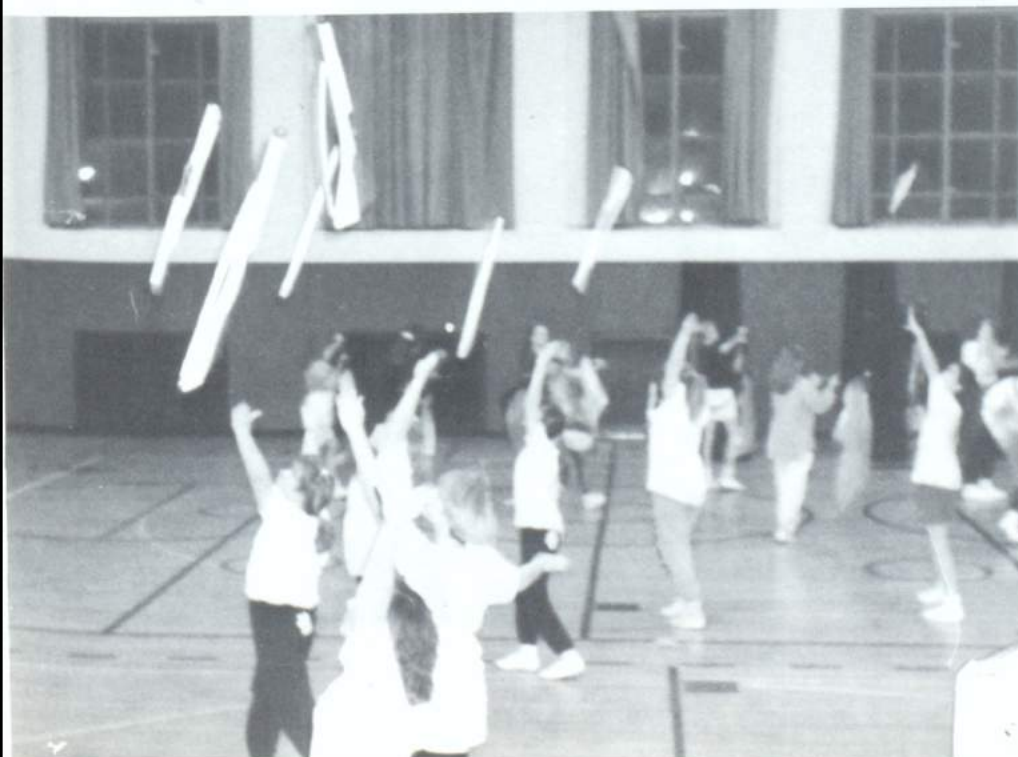

# National Honor Society

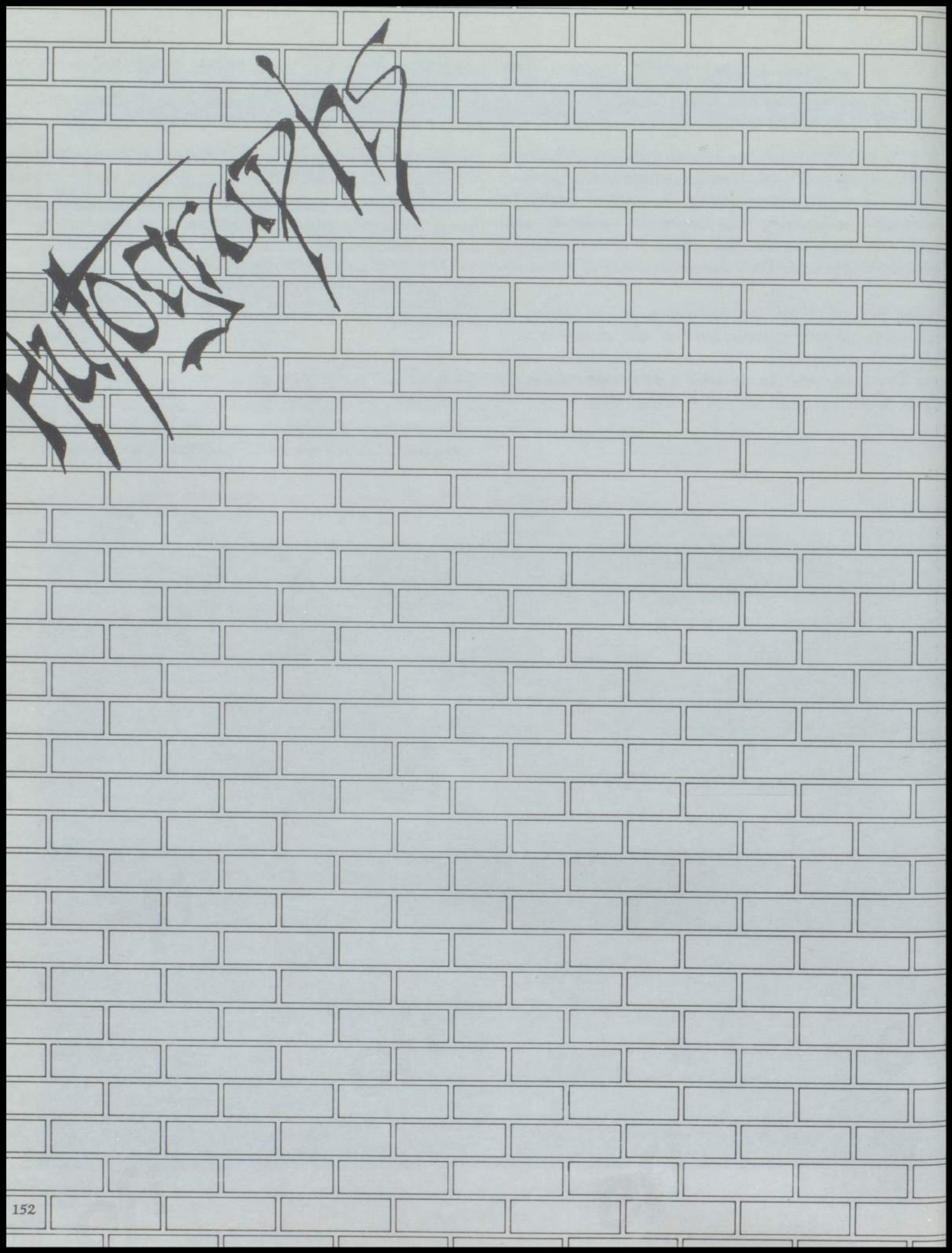

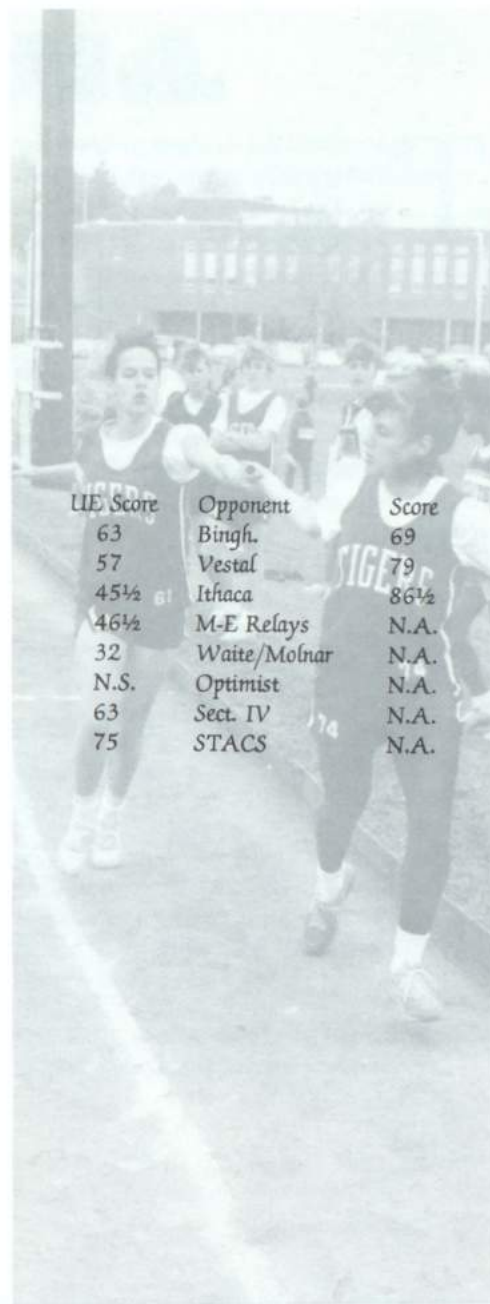

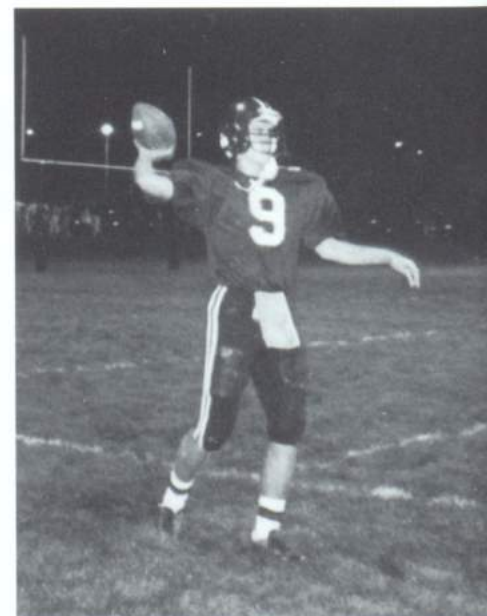


# VARSITY FOOTBALL

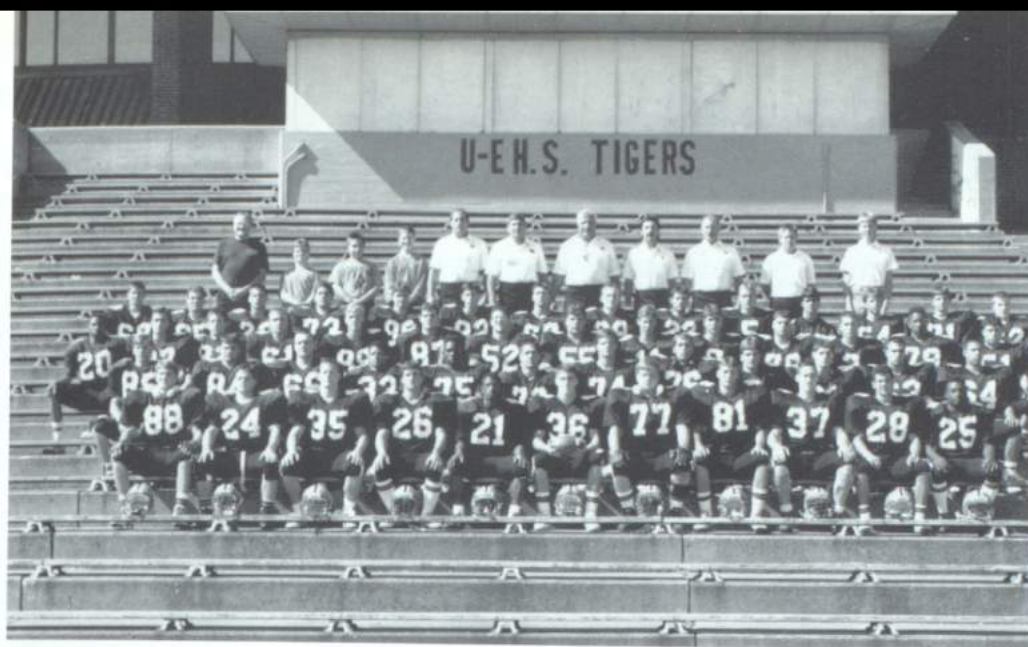
