


What was Mr. Rinde doing on Jeopardy?






Italian Club

Educators have recognized the advantages of on-the-job training as part of an occupational education. Mr. William Dupkanick coordinates two such programs, Youth Apprenticeship and Co-op.

Union-Endicott High School began offering the Youth Apprenticehship Program (YAP) during the 1991-92 school year. Stella Anastos, Robin Cooper, and Hope Eason were selected to participate. All three are currently enrolled in their first of this two-year program. Stella is employed at UHS Binghamton General Hospital: Robin is employed at Blue Cross Blue Shield of Western New York; and Hope is employed at IBM Corp. of Endicott. Students in the YAP are eligible to receive two Regents credits for each year in the program. In addition, all three can receive a fifth credit by completing an additional project that requires extensive work. Stella, Robin, and Hope can earn up to five credits, receive a stipend, and gain first-hand experience through the Youth Apprenticeship Program.

The Co-op Program has existed for more than thirty years at Union-Endicott High School and has offered hundreds of students the opportunity to gain experience, earn money, and receive school for their efforts. During 1994-95 three students participated in the Co-op Program. Michele Payne is employed at The Bay Ridge Group: Ann Cicciarelli is employed at Satico's; Erin Becker is employed at the Binghamton Savings Bank, Endicott office; and Kayrn Sluzar is working at the Union-Endicott School District Computer Center on Broad Street. Co-op Students earn one-half credit for each one-hundred and fifty hours of work experience up to two credits.















The 1994 varsity baseball team completed a successful season of 13-6 overall. The team was just one game away from making the STAC playoffs.
























National health care legislation, President Clinton's grandest legislative goal of the year, failed to come to a vote in Congress in the final months of the year. The legislation would have guaranteed medical care to all Americans. It staggered under the weight of withering attacks from Republicans and insurance interests for many months. President Clinton and other Demorcrats immediately said they would try to bring health care Igeislation back to life next year.

President Clinton signed a \$30 billion **Crime Bill.** The huge law bans the manufacture, sale and possession of 19 specific types of assault-style weapons. It also allows the death penalty for 60 additional federal crimes, including drive-by shooting and carjacking deaths. As for the money, the law authorizes billions of dollars over six years to build prisons and hire more police. Attorney General Janet Reno said that 20,000 new police officers should be on the streets by 1996.



Tropical Storm Alberto hit the South, and the **Georgia floods** made history. The storm unloaded more than 20 inches of rain and caused flooding that killed 31 people. Fortynine counties were declared federal disaster area and about 46,000 people were driven from their homes. In Albany, 30,000 people were evacuated and 9,200 houses and apartments were damaged or destroyed.



The torch was passed in the summer of 1994. After hearing about the legendary rock festival from their parents for years, a new generation seized the opportunity to create their own Woodstock. And Woodstock '94 was born. Several hundred thousands people arrived at Saugerties, N.Y. for Woodstock, '94. From folk music to heavey metal, the weekend concert was filled with music almost 24 hours a day.

Forest Fires swept across more than a dozen western states. An eight-year drought brought the United States its worst forest fires since the 1920's, blackening some 3 million acres. Fourteen firefighters were killed in a blaze in Colorado. Thousands of firefighters from all over the country were mobilized to keep the fires under control.
