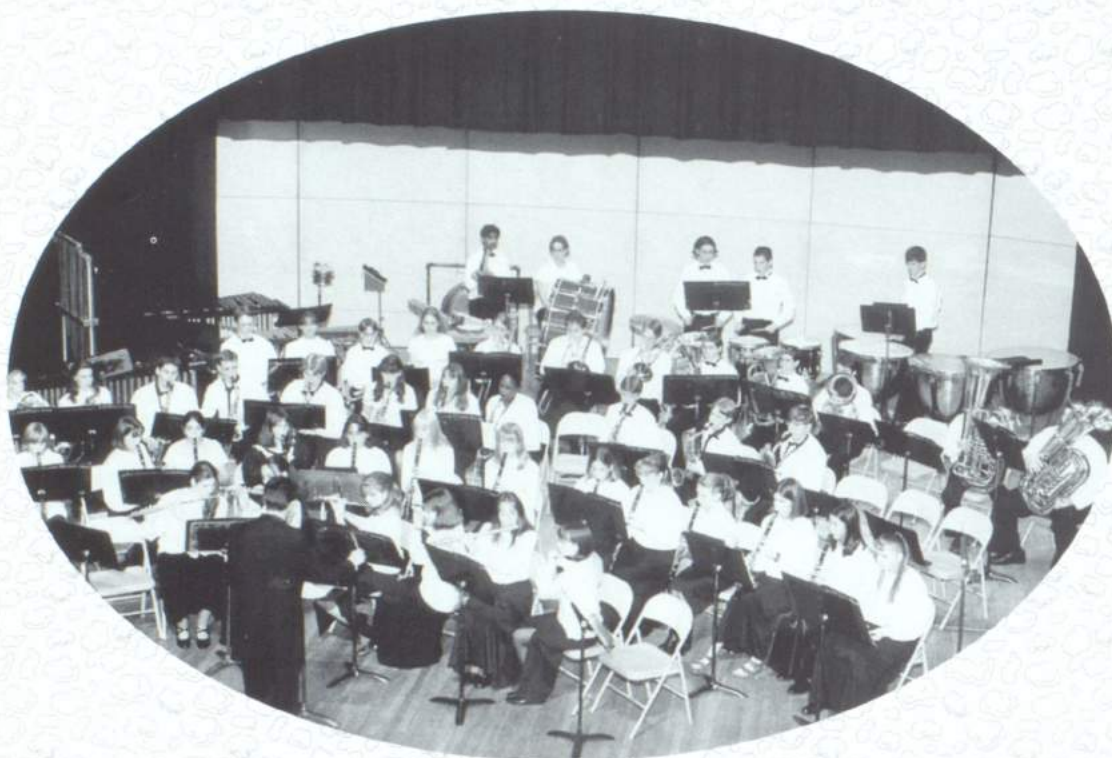


Symphonic Band
