# May Classes at the GFJ Tech Center!

## **Ancestry.com: Trace Your Genealogy** Saturday 5/14 at 1:00

- This workshop is an introduction to the Ancestry Library Edition database, which is FREE to use at the library. Users can search U.S. census records, Social Security records, birth and death records, immigration records, military and other vital records for genealogical research. Target audience is BEGINNERS. **Please bring your library card to class.**

## **Android Smartphone and Tablet Basics** Wednesday 5/4 at 5:00

- Android is a popular operating system which is used on different mobile devices such as phones and tablets. The Android system was made by Google. This workshop will show you how to navigate through the various controls and effectively use an Android device. **Please bring your Android device (phone or tablet) with you.**

## **Dropbox and Cloud Sharing** Saturday 5/21 at 1:00

- Dropbox is a service that keeps your files safe, synced, and easy to share. This class will show you how to use this Cloud storage to save and share your photos, docs, and videos and never lose a file again.

## **Editing and Sharing Digital Photos** Thursday 5/19 at 4:00

- Don't keep your photos trapped on your phone or camera! This introductory class will show you how to easily edit and share your digital photos with free programs and websites.
