Computer Vocabulary Wednesday 7/13 at 5:00 or Monday 7/18 at 10:00

• This Basics class will improve your everyday computer vocabulary, enabling you to use correct terminology when communicating with others about computers. It will also increase your comprehension and ease in any future computer classes!

Cut, Copy, Paste—and Other Essential Word Skills Wednesday 7/20 at 5:00 or Friday, 7/22 at 10:00

• Have you ever wanted to really understand how to cut, copy and paste in Microsoft Word? How about changing the font size, *style*, or **color**? Are you interested in manipulating margins and line spacing, creating a bulleted list, or learning how to use tables, among many other Word skills? Then don't miss this class! We will focus on the "ribbon" in Word 2013, but these basic skills transfer to many other word processing programs. Bring your Word questions to class!

Files and Folders for Beginners Thursday 7/14 at 10:00

• This Basics class will introduce you to managing files and folders on a computer. We will look at finding, creating, saving, and deleting files and folders. During the class you will practice with files and folders, leaving with a better understanding of opening and saving files.
