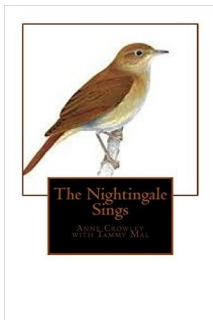
## February @ the GFJ Library
