Amazon Fire: An Affordable Tablet Tuesday 10/31 from 1:00-3:00

- If you're interested in an affordable tablet, or if you want to get an early jump on your holiday shopping, consider an Amazon Fire Tablet. For under \$50 you can buy a solidly built tablet with decent performance. This workshop will outline the features of the Amazon Fire Tablet, plus introduce Alexa, the built in digital assistant. The Amazon Echo, a voice-enabled wireless speaker developed by Amazon.com, will also be demonstrated.

Ancestry.com—Library Edition—for Beginners Tuesday 10/17 from 1:00-3:00

- This workshop is an introduction to the Ancestry Library edition database. Users can search U.S. census records, Social Security records, birth and death records, immigration records, military and other vital records for genealogical research. This workshop is targeted to BEGINNERS and those who have not used the Ancestry Library Edition, which is available FREE at the library.
