Apps for Home and Garden Thursday 4/19 from 4:00-6:00

- Getting ready for Spring? There are dozens of free apps that will help you spruce up your home or plan a fabulous garden. Bring your iPad or Android device and your Apple or Google password if you want to download and get started.

Digital Assistants: What Can They Do? Friday 4/27 from 1:00-3:00

- A digital assistant (sometimes called a virtual assistant) is voice-activated software that can understand and carry out electronic tasks for you. If you have a smartphone, tablet, or newer computer, there's a good chance it has a built-in digital assistant. Google Assistant and Amazon Alexa are the two most popular standalone digital assistants that can be purchased at a reasonable cost. Attend this workshop and find out what a digital assistant can do!

How Do You Know if What You Read Online is TRUE? Saturday 4/28 from 1:00-3:00

- Anyone can post information on the Internet, but how can we tell what is true, and what is a scam? This class will explore and discuss tips and tools that we can use to help verify information on the Internet, and to help us become more discerning readers.

Managing Digital Photos Friday 4/6 from 1:00-3:00

- Don't keep your photos trapped on your phone or camera! This class will help you transfer them to your computer, improve them with a few quick edits, and save online to keep them safe and accessible. You may bring your laptop if you wish, and your phone or camera.

Online Streaming: Services and Devices Friday 4/13 from 1:00-3:00

- This workshop will cover some of the major online service options and online streaming devices available to consumers. Anyone with an Internet connection can stream movies and television programs for free or subscribe to an inexpensive online streaming service provider. Find out how easy it is to stream content to your TV or tablet computer.

Security for Home Computers Saturday 4/21 from 1:00-3:00

- People often think of computer security as something technical and complicated. Actually, the most important stuff is actually very simple. This workshop will cover the basic, important things you should do to secure your home computer and make yourself safer online.
