

Android Smartphone and Tablet Basics Tuesday 6/4 from 3:00-5:00

- Android is a popular operating system which is used on different mobile devices such as phones and tablets. This workshop will show you how to navigate through the various features and controls to effectively use an Android device. Please bring your charged Android device (phone or tablet) with you.

Ancestry.com-Library Edition- for beginners Thursday 6/13 from 1:00-3:00

- This workshop is an introduction to the Ancestry Library Edition database. Users can search U.S. census records, Social Security records, birth and death records, immigration records, military and other vital records for genealogical research.
