Amazon Fire: The Affordable Tablet Tuesday 9/24 from 3:00-5:00

- The Fire, formerly called the Kindle Fire, is a tablet computer developed by Amazon.com. An overview of the Amazon Fire Tablet will be presented including how to navigate, organize and download apps. The latest Fire delivers faster performance, a bigger battery and more base storage than the previous version for almost half the price. Its screen is bright, the speakers are loud, and it offers expandable microSD storage and ample parental controls. **Registration Required.**

Android Smartphone and Tablet Basics Thursday 9/5 from 1:00-3:00

- Android is a popular operating system which is used on different mobile devices such as phones and tablets. The Android system was created by Google.
