Introduction to Zoom – March 19th at 3:00pm

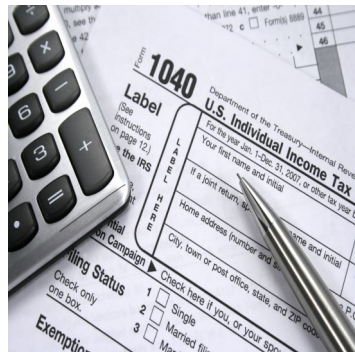
