#### Town of Union Library Funding Referendums Historical Data

In 2004, the voters of the Town of Union approved taxes to fund the town's two public libraries - Your Home Public Library in Johnson City and George F. Johnson Memorial Library in Endicott. This funding kept both libraries open and allowed them to return to a full level of service after years of cuts. Town voters approved funding increases in 2008, 2014, and 2019. There has been no increase in the past six years.




