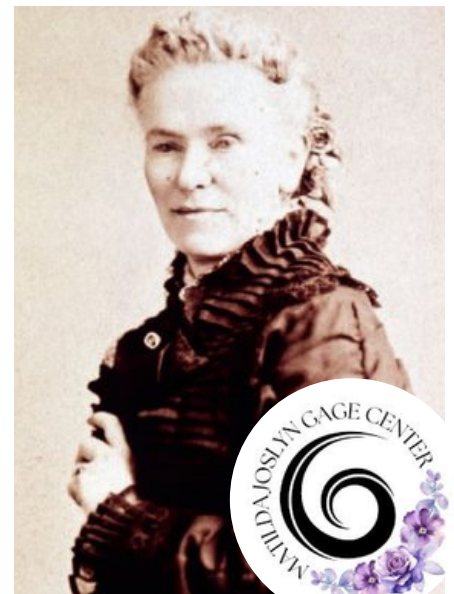
Celebrating the Legacy of Matilda Joslyn Gage: This March, we are proud to honor the life and work of Matilda Joslyn Gage, a powerful yet often underrecognized voice in the 19th-century fight for equality. A passionate suffragist, writer, and activist, Gage dedicated her life to advancing women's rights, defending Native American sovereignty, and challenging the social and religious injustices of her time. Did you know?



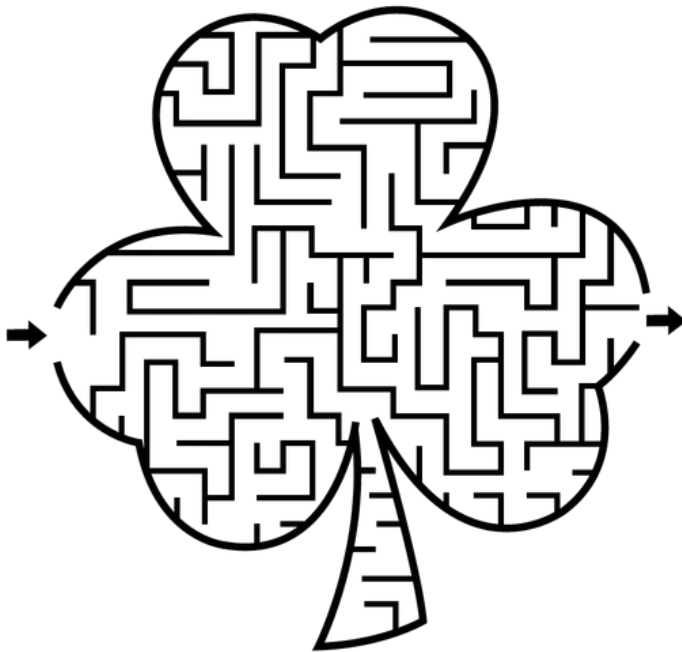
