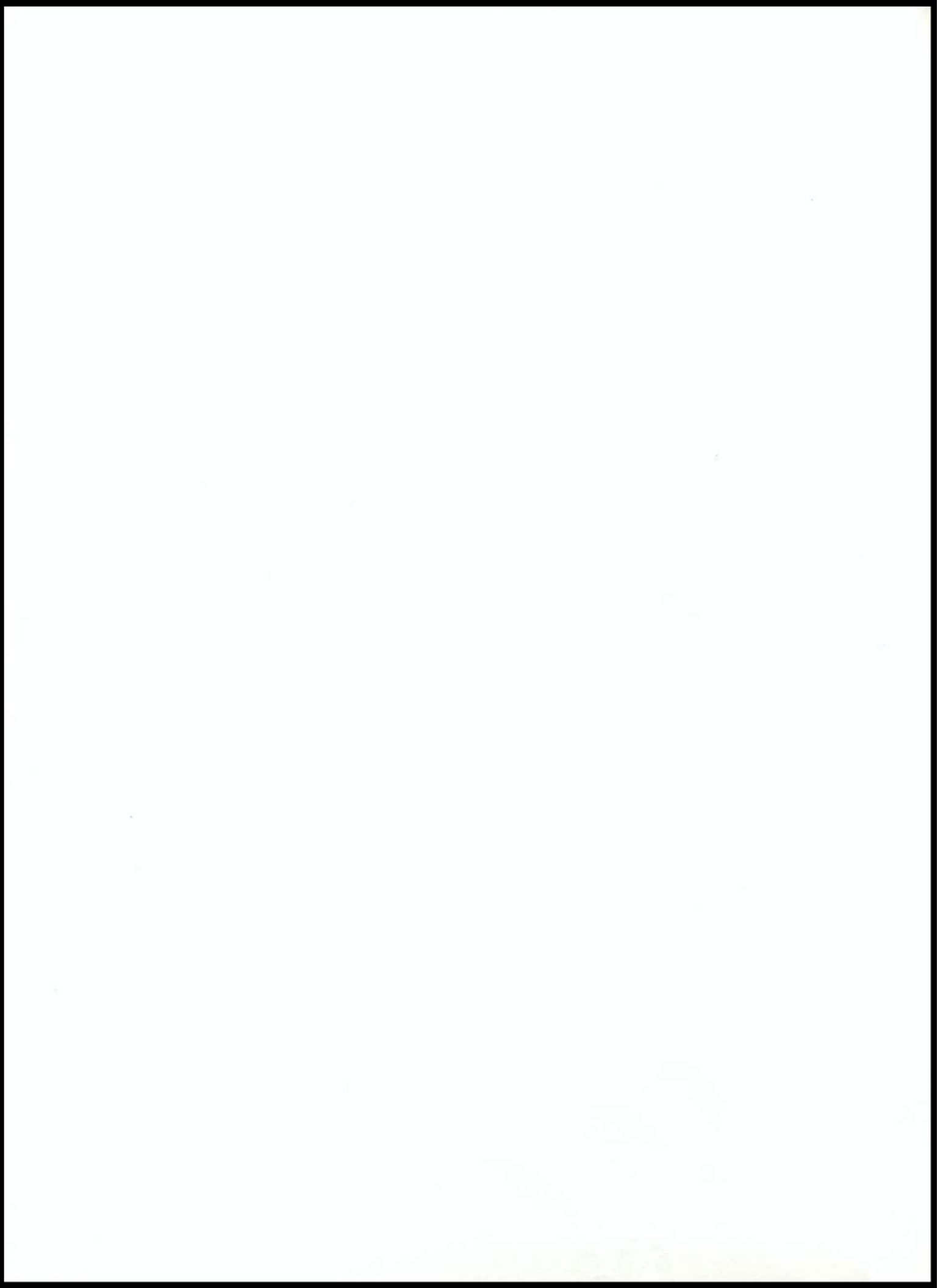

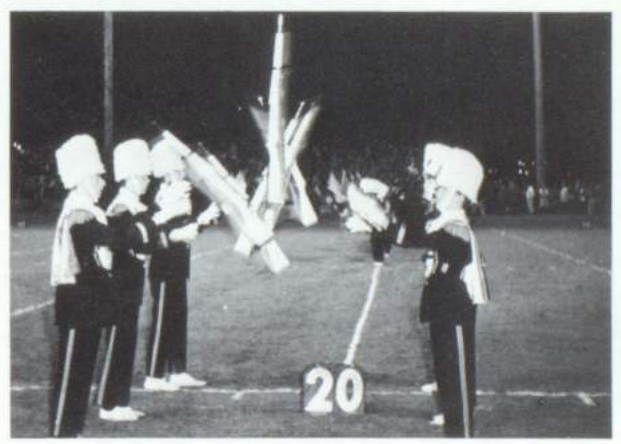

"Neath the Orange and the Black.













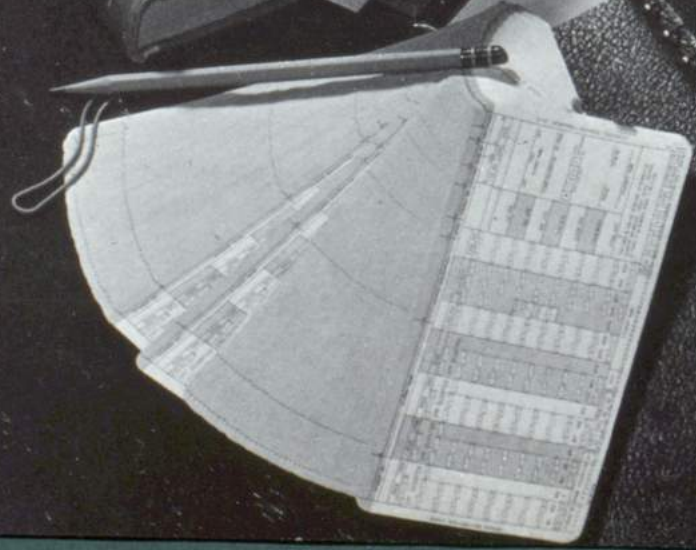
