ACTIVITIES

Amnesty International



Amnesty International is a worldwide organization working for the protection of human rights. It seeks the release of prisoners of conscience: men and women who do not advocate violence and are detained because of their beliefs, sex, color, language, ethnic origin or religious creed. Through persistent writing and petitioning, AI seeks fair and prompt trials for all political prisoners and opposes cruel treatment of all prisoners.

Co-Op / Y.A.P.



The Co-Op Program has existed for more than thirty years at Union Endicott High School and has offered hundreds of students the opportunity to gain experience, earn money, and receive school credit for their efforts. During the 1995-96 school year many students have participated in the Co-Op program. Two of the many students are Kayrn Sluzar and Melissa Fye. Co-Op students earn one-half credit for each one-hundred and fifty hours of work experience up to two credits.

Drama Club

The 1995-96 Drama Club put on the successful melodrama, Million-Dollar Baby, and with experienced actors, and some hardworking rookies the show was a Four Star(★★★★) production. We also put on many one act plays, and excerpts from the play, "Little Women." In the spring, the Drama Club put on a Drama Competition, consisting of many categories, and was open to the school for any striving actors or actresses. Next year we plan to open the competition to area schools to widen the variety of actors.



The Drama Club has approximately twenty members. The advisor is Mrs. Lois James.

French Club

This year the French Club went to New York City to see Phantom of the Opera. In December, we celebrated "Le Jour du Saint Nicolas." Our major activity for 1995 was the "Angel Tree", which was done with the Salvation Army, and coordinated for UE by Rickey Nicholas. Each student who volunteered received a "child" for whom the student had to buy its 2 wishes. We helped over 25 kids in the community. We also celebrated La Fete du Roi, had the French exchange to Lyon, and took a trip to NYC to see "Beauty and the Beast".

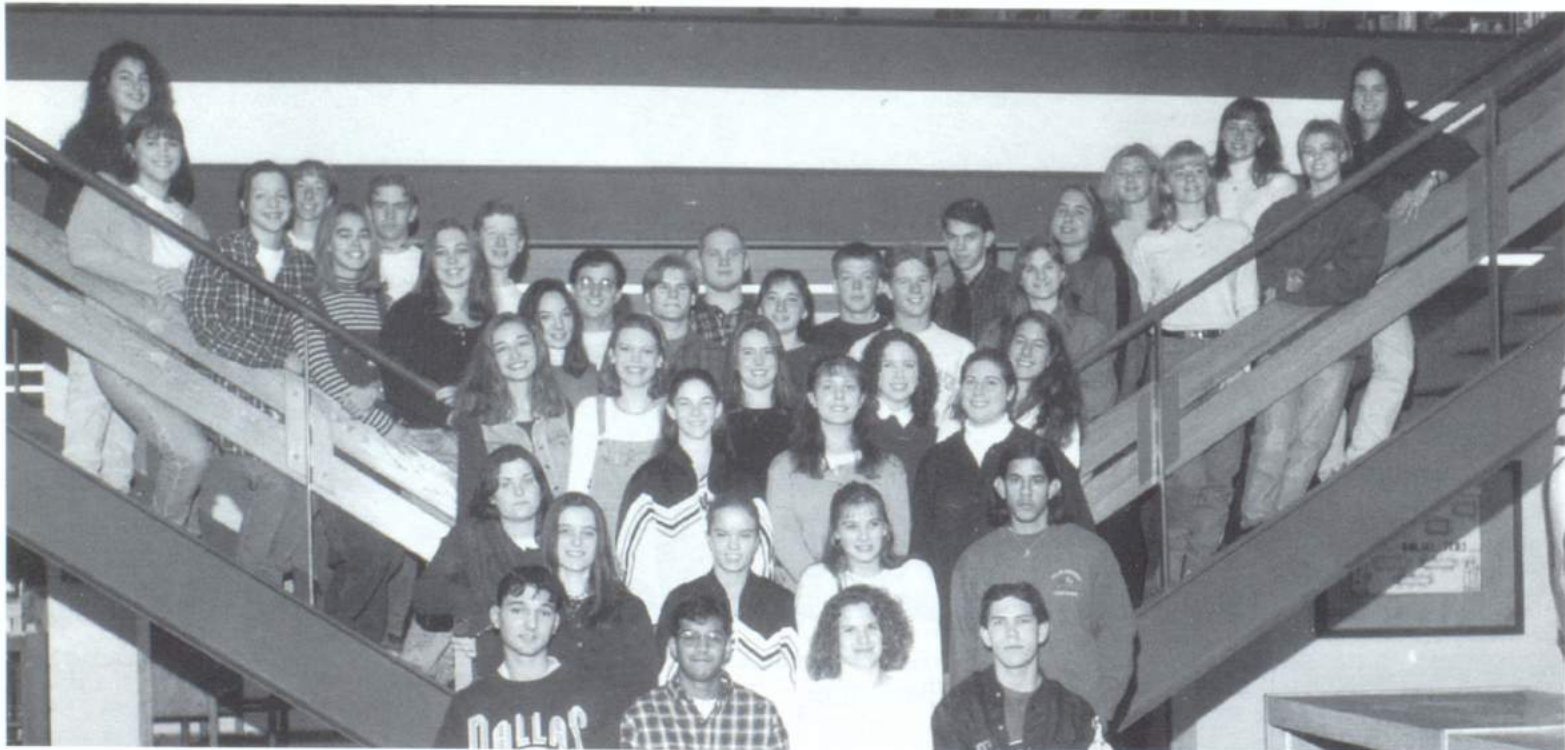

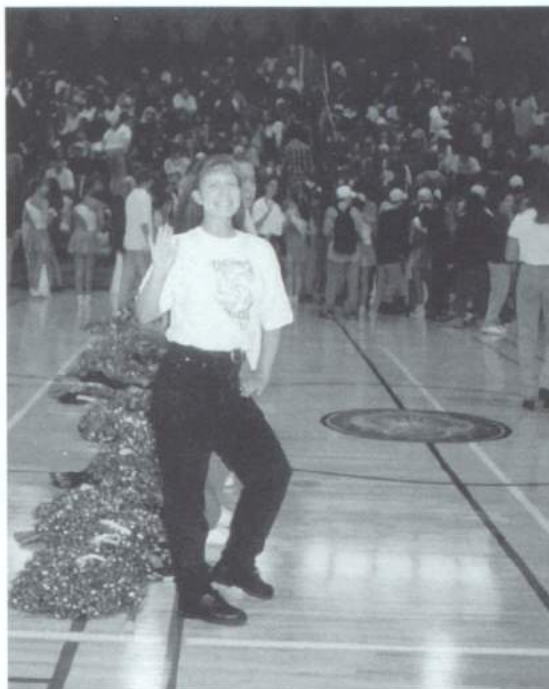
National Honor Society

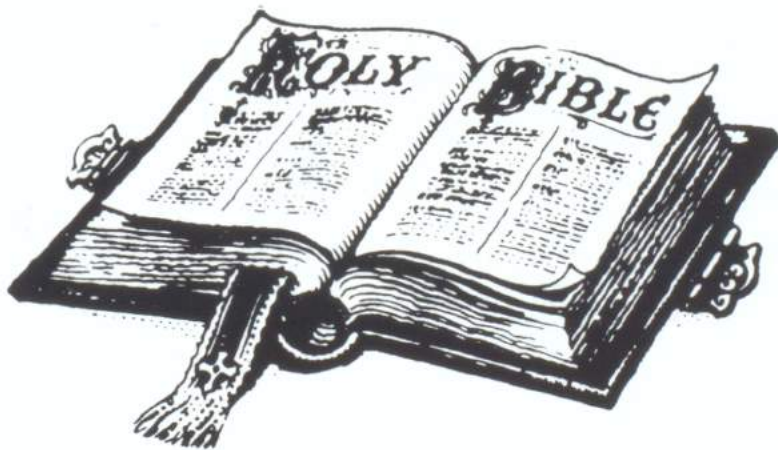
Youth Leadership
