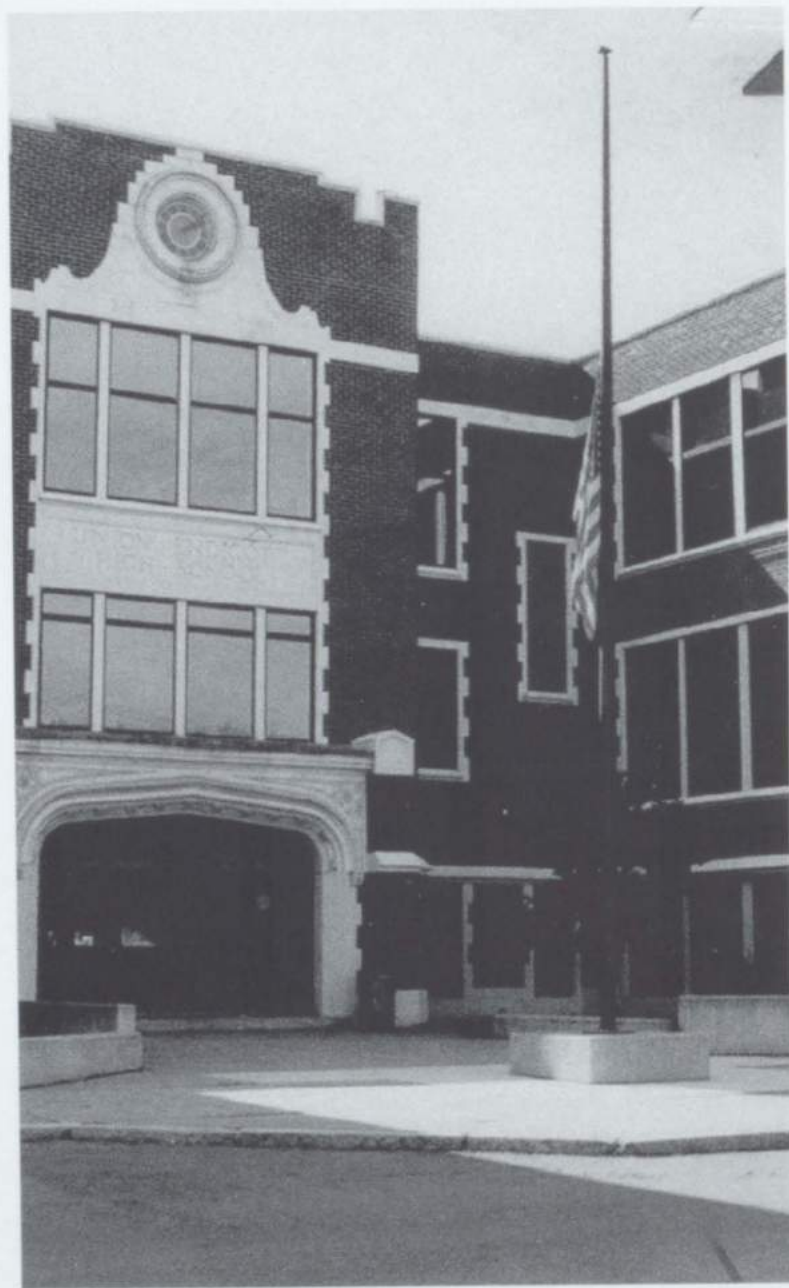


# Friends. . .





Something can happen today or tomorrow that can completely change everything. Rick Friend, Sept. 10, 2001.



Mr. Friend said these words to his U.S. History class on September 10, 2001. The next day, his students, as well as the rest of us, understood his words completely as we watched two planes strike the World Trade Center in New York City, the Pentagon, and a field in Pennsylvania.

None of us will forget where we were that day, and who we were with. As our yearbook staff interviewed teachers about September 11, we found that nearly everyone called a family member during that day. They remembered who told them, and where they were standing or sitting when they found out. That moment of time is frozen in our thoughts.

We know September 11 will always be remembered as a part of this school year. The yearbook staff would like to share some of the thoughts from faculty and staff, as well as some memories of the day. For many, this time became a teaching moment like no other. For America, the overwhelming response to help, and to persevere, became Our Finest Hour.

# Academics

As the events unfolded, many students and staff feared for the safety of their friends or relatives who were on planes or in the buildings. Most were not afraid for their personal safety, but rather it was more of a fear of what else may come. Mr. Bossong made an announcement around noon giving some calming information and letting us know that at this point it we would be staying in school. However, as most schools in the nation, all after school activities were canceled.

"It can be compared to life situations on a daily basis-- don't take what you have come to rely on just for granted. Like the tragedy of September 11, these things can be taken away in the blink of an eye. So cherish the moments, the big and the small." --Mrs. Leonard

Nothing in life can really compare to the horror of September 11th. To be honest, I am still, even as I respond to this question several months later, deeply shocked and confused by how something so evil could unfold before our very eyes. We seem to have a natural tendency to feel as though everything must be compared-to immediately draw a connection between the events of that unforgettable morning and Pearl Harbor, for instance. To me these events were so extraordinarily set apart from one another that I never saw the relevance of such a comparisons. Some people wanted to think of it as a movie, and I felt like saying "WHLAT movie? Not one that I would ever want to watch! --Mr. Palmatier

The sum of the effects of September 11 were felt immediately, the loss of life, the destruction of two monumental landscapes, and the great impact on Wall Street on that day and several days to come. Other ripple effects, especially financial took longer to be made obvious. Schools lost millions of dollars of state funding, effecting our budgets drastically. But of all the financial effects, the most profound effect was in our thinking. Most Americans felt safe from terrorists. Terrorism happened in the middle east, and other countries. Not here.

At 8:45 a.m. that morning, I was explaining the difficulty photojournalists face when going into a war zone, and how tough it is for us to relate because it doesn't happen here. I turned on the video we'd been watching about photojournalism and its dangers, when at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Solati came running in and told us to turn off the video, that something had happened here. All of a sudden we were watching a place we knew well become a war zone. It wasn't a remote country anymore. It was here. --Miss Baker

Over the next several days, teachers and students joined together to raise money or items to assist families and rescue workers. Students came in and commented on how they'd been talking to their parents or grandparents about Pearl Harbor and the day that President Kennedy died. Because of this tragedy families came closer together, and it brought out the best in nearly everyone in our school & across the nation.





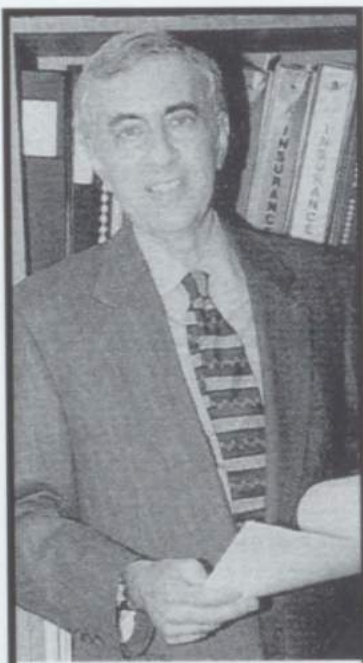

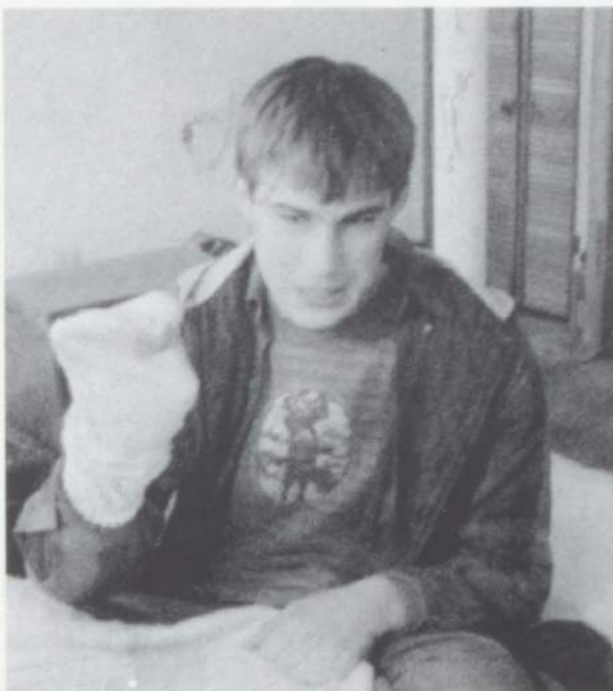


## High Insanity Rate Among Yearbook Staff Members Raises Eyebrows

## Jazz Choir

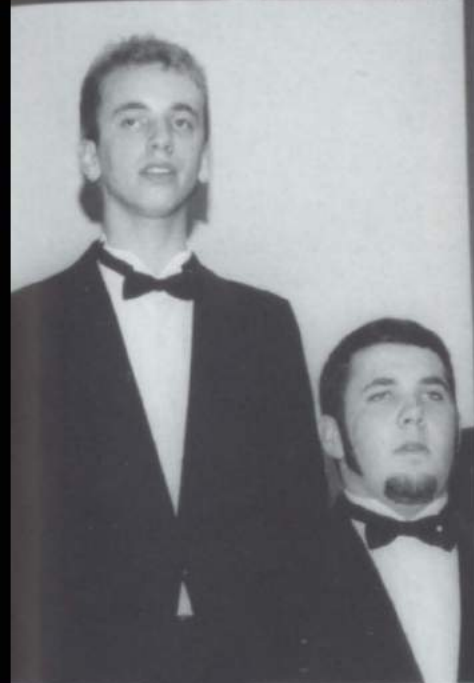

Freshman Band is comprised of 9th grade students and is under the direction of Mr. Weber.

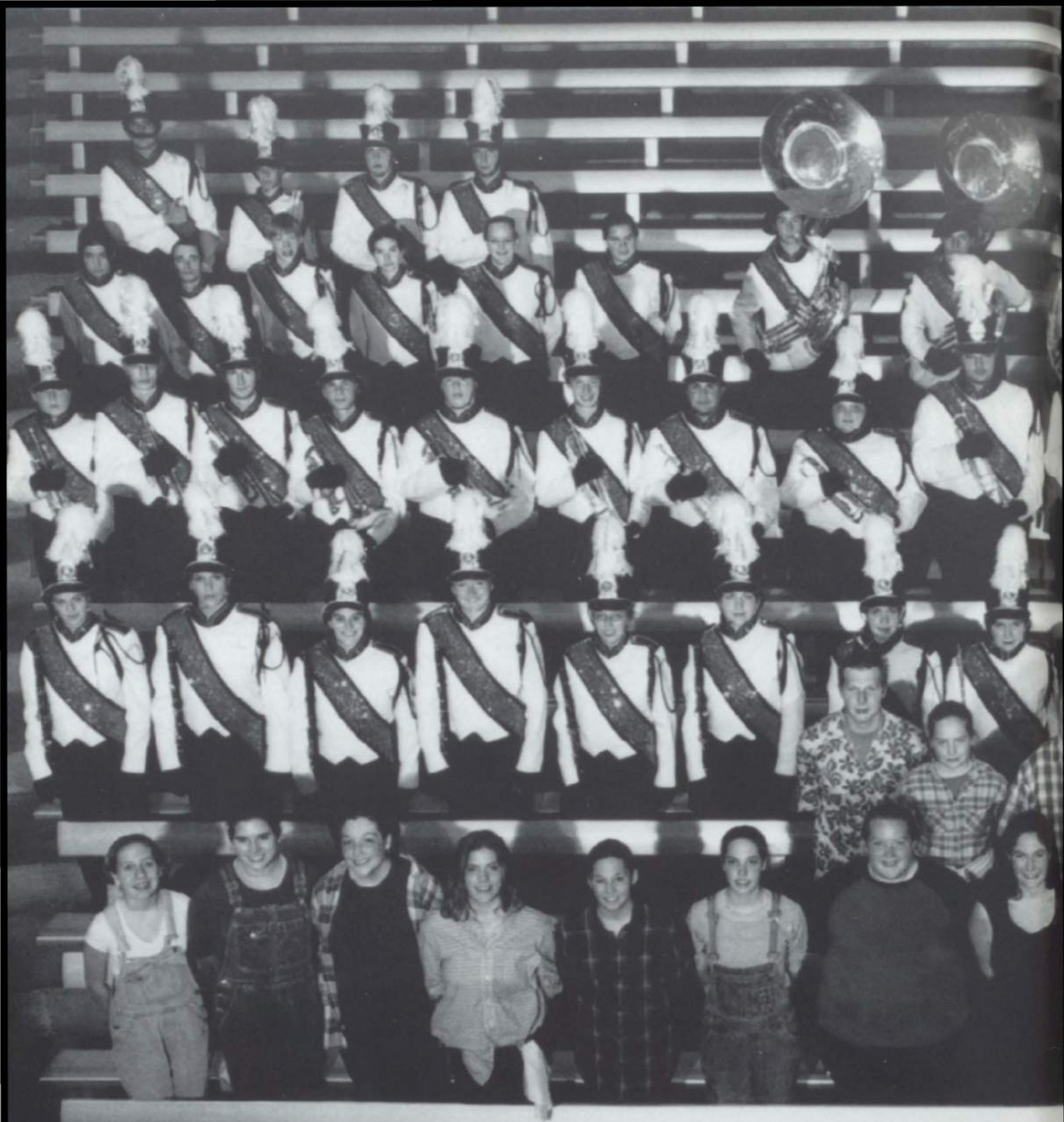

# Mathletes

The U-E Mathletes is a club whose members have an interest in problem solving techniques and who enjoy participating in numerous competitions. All Students are welcome to join.

Each month, a Team of 5 to 7 students travels to Johnson City High School to compete against the other Broome County schools in a competition consisting of 5 individual problems and one team relay problem. The cumulative total of members' points determines the winning individuals and schools. The top 17 students from Broome County are then collected into a Southern Tier team, which competes in April's State Mathletes Meet.

Each month members also participate in the New York Math League Test, which is administered in each school, and the results are mailed in to a central office.

In February, the American High School Math Exam is administered. This is a 90-minute test that over 500,000 students take. Students who qualify are then eligible for scholarships, and are also given the opportunity to go to the next level test, eventually leading all the way to a place on the United States Math Olympic Team.

At the awards ceremony for seniors, a prize is given to those students who were contributing members of the Mathletes team. Mrs. Ritinger is the Mathletes' advisor.
