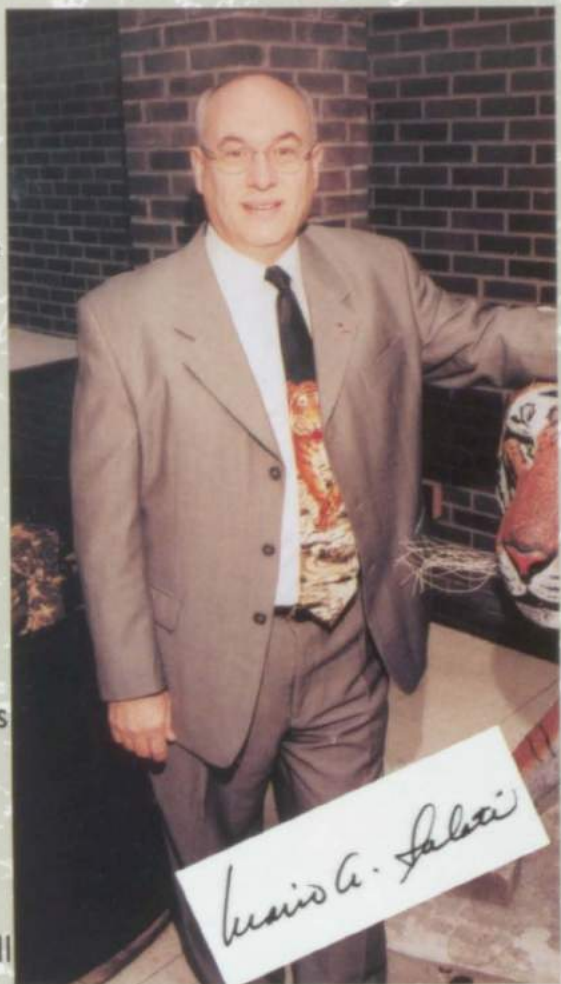


## UEHS welcomes Mr. Mario Salati as our new Principal!
